We are Heart and Home Collaborative and we operate a cold weather shelter in North Santa Clara County every winter in a way that values relationships and respect. Heart and Home fills a critical need for all women -- a shelter space. Every winter we rotate through houses of faith, providing hot meals, community, and a place to sleep for approximately 15 unhoused women at a time. Heart and Home is built on the fundamental idea that safe shelter is a human right and every person deserves to be treated with kindness and dignity.

In June, Heart and Home's trailer, with all our shelter supplies, was stolen from a donated parking space in Palo Alto. We depend on the trailer to support our rotating shelter model. As a small organization with zero office space, we store absolutely everything our shelter needs in the trailer.
